Eat and drink like there is no tomorrow – or 100 miles of riding...



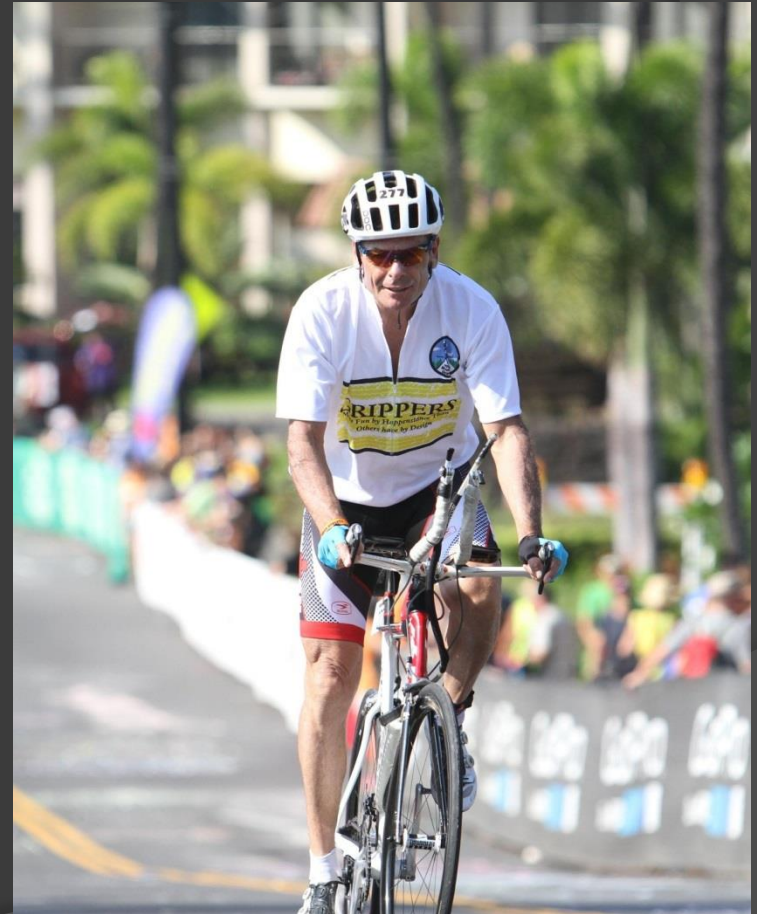
Step Three: Ride a bit two weeks ahead of the event. Then, taper.

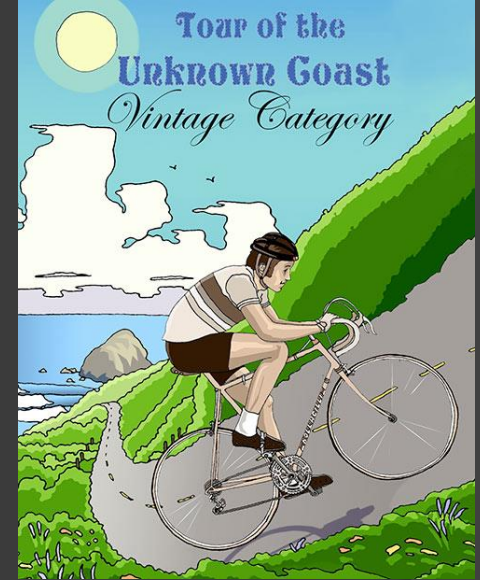
